**WHEREAS**, high-quality infrastructure, including roads and bridges, is an essential requirement for continued growth and economic development; and



**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the North Houston Association supports the preferred alternative alignment and associated environmental impacts contained in the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for Segment F-2 from SH 249 to IH 45. The project will provide improved access to the existing and future thoroughfare system, reduce area traffic congestion, improve safety, and improve area-wide mobility. This project will ultimately create a cost-effective, efficient transportation system essential for the quality of life that we support.
