TX SH 249 Roadway Extension Project Overview

The Texas (TX) State Highway (SH) 249 Extension Project is approximately 24 miles of new roadway from Farm-to-Market (FM) 1774 in Pinehurst in Montgomery County to SH 105 near Navasota in Grimes County.

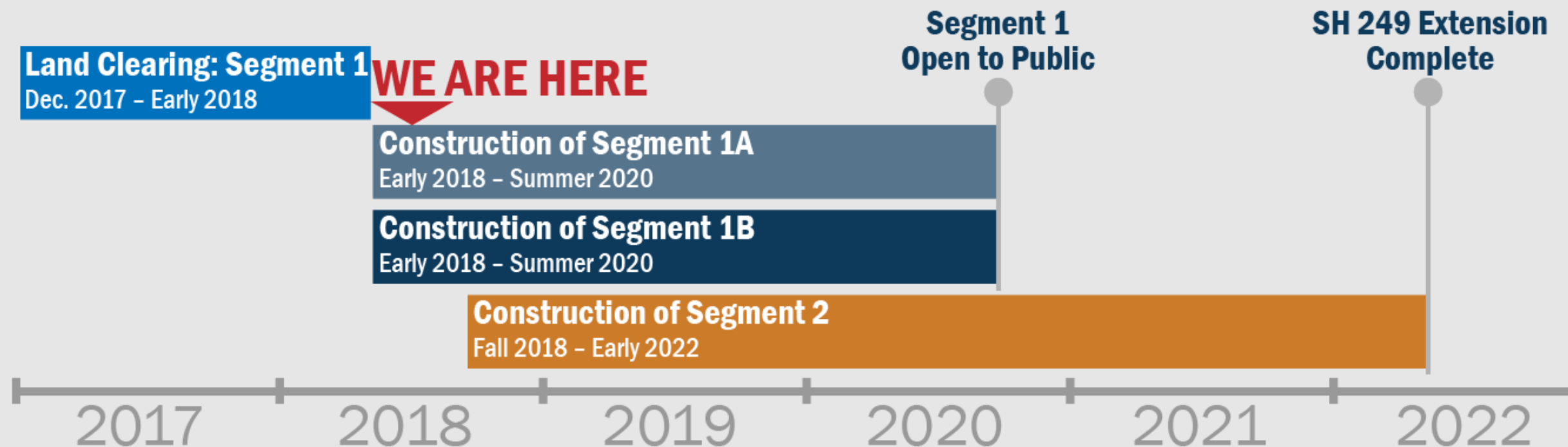
- Segment 1 of the Project will be constructed as a 14 mile, four-lane controlled-access tollway with intermittent frontage roads from FM 1774 in Pinehurst to FM 1774 in Todd Mission.
- Segment 2 of the Project will be constructed as a 10 mile, two-lane non-tolled highway from FM 1774 in Todd Mission to SH 105 between Plantersville and Navasota.

The purpose of the project is to provide a safe, reliable, cost-effective, and visually pleasing corridor for the traveling public by linking suburban communities with major roadways and improving mobility and safety.

Segment Map

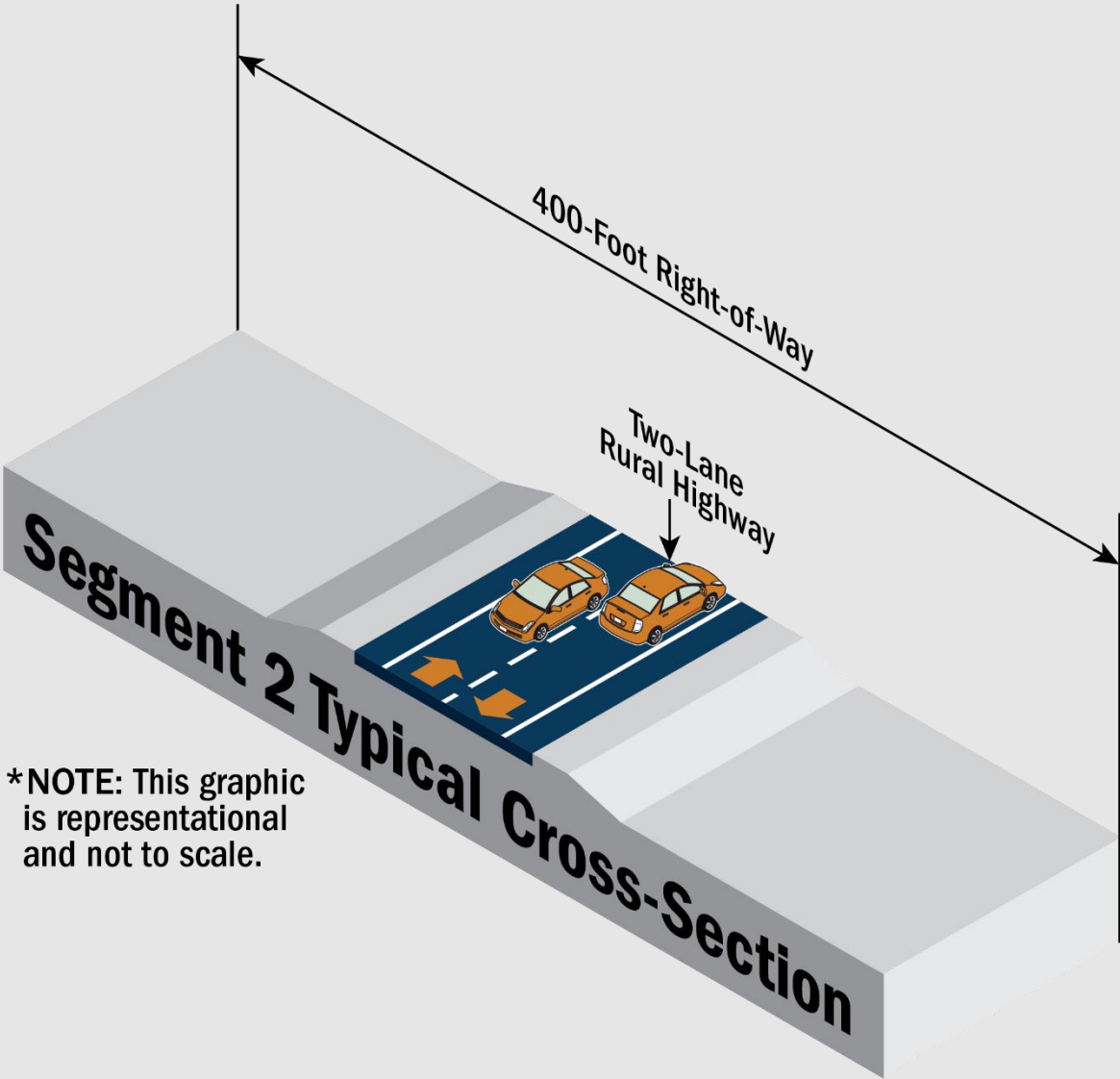
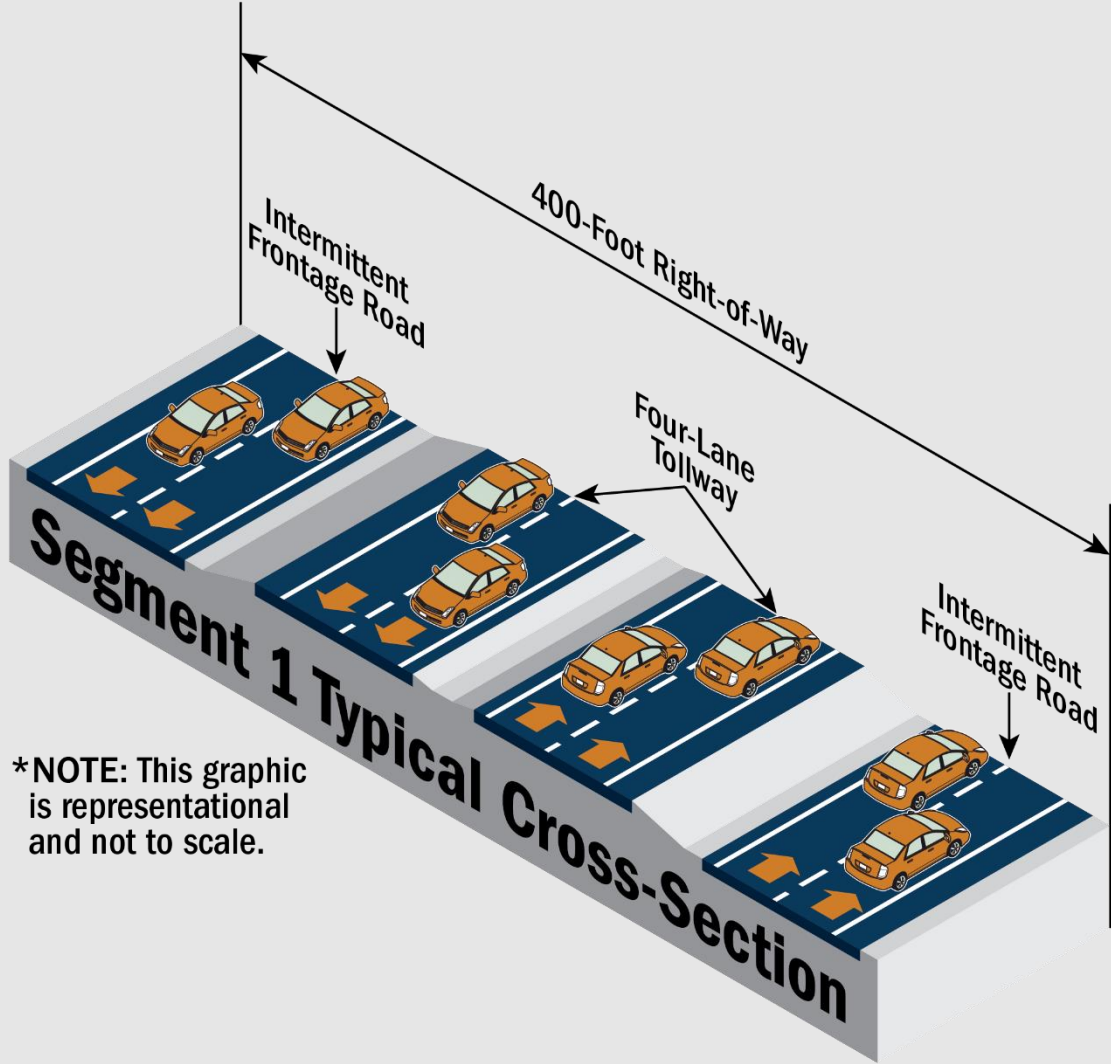


Project To Date



- Segment 1: Clearing began in December 2017, Earthwork began on March 16, 2018 and Construction will be complete summer 2020.
- Segment 2: Construction activities are scheduled to begin fall 2018 and are expected to be complete early 2022.

Segment Typical Cross-Section



- Segment 1: Over 80% of ROW has been acquired by either TxDOT or DB Contractor. The remaining three parcels are in the acquisition process.
- Segment 2: TxDOT is proceeding to acquire all parcels.

Design Status

- Segment 1 is at 60% overall design for earthwork, drainage, retaining walls, and bridges. All designs for Segment 1 will be complete before June 15, 2018.
- Utility design has begun on several utility re-locations. All utility relocations should be completed by the end of 2018.
