

Thomas C. Lambert Bio

Thomas C. Lambert (Tom) serves as president & chief executive officer of Houston METRO, a role he has held for the last 10 years, including two years as acting president & CEO. He leads a staff of more than 4000 people, all committed to providing safe, clean, reliable, accessible, and friendly public transportation for a region spanning 1300 square miles.

Lambert has been with the organization for more than 40 years and is credited with creating the Authority's police force and leading that team of law enforcement professionals for a number of years. From there, he went on to serve as a senior vice president, chief administrative officer, and executive vice president for the agency. In each of those roles, Lambert has made delivering timely and efficient service that connects communities to everyday work and life opportunities a priority.

Lambert led the organization as it launched the New Bus Network, expanded METRORail by adding the Green and Purple lines, brought the first bus rapid transit technology to the region with METRORapid Silver Line and provided the agency's first on-demand, personalized service with its curb2curb shuttles.

During Lambert's tenure, Houston METRO has been named Outstanding Metropolitan Transit System of the Year by the Texas Transit Association, honored three times as Outstanding Public Transportation System by the American Public Transportation Association and received the Superior Performance Award from the U.S. Department of Transportation Safety Institute.
